



7° Meeting "City of CALANGIANUS", **ITALY GRAND PRIX delle NAZIONI** **Official Rules**

INTRODUCTION

The 7th Meeting "Città di Calangianus - Italia Gran Prix delle Nazioni" is composed by the following two tournaments:

- 1. Sardinia region qualification tournament**
- 2. Main Tournament**

1.0 - General rules

The Qualification tournament is OPEN and will be played only by Italian Fibus Players (2021-22) coming from Sport Clubs from Sardinia region.

2.0 - Main Tournament

- Nr. 28 Seeded players coming from European Countries (2 players from each country, depending on the number of countries invited and then involved)
- 4 Players coming from the Qualification tournament

2.1 - Seeded players are coming from the following countries, the list may change due to players confirmation.

2.2 - If a Federation is unable to replace one of his players, the same place will be assigned to another player under organizer decision.

3.0 - Playing rules

The 32 players will be divided by draw into 8 groups of 4 players each and will play a round robin qualification best of 3 sets to 100 points The first two players of each group will qualify for the last 16, where will be played a KO tournament on best of 3 sets to 120 points

3.1 - Groups will be done by draw by the organizer and the players from the same countries will be splitted into different groups.

The playing sequence will be the following:

- 1° round: 1-4; 2-3;
- 2° round: 1-3; 2-4;



- 3° round: 1-2; 3-4;

Should occur than two or more players from the same country lay into the same group, then they will play the first game against, so their position will be defined as 1 and 4

3.2 - The organizer will give and show a timetable at the start of the Meeting. Should in any case and for any reason happen that this timetable has to be changed, the player involved will be immediately informed by the responsible of the tournament.

Players should be ready to play at the tables and time shown in the time-table, otherwise their participation will be cancelled.

Timetable will be public and will be published and shown at least 1 hour before the start of the first match of the round robin (see att. n°1)

3.3 - Should a player do a no-show, at his playing time, his match will be considered lost and his opponent will gain +1 match point and +2 set points.

3.4 - Each player should be ready 15 minutes before the start of each match, otherwise he will lose the possibility to test the table before the game.

3.5 – Should a player have to play two matches in sequence, he has the right to have 15 minutes rest between the matches.

3.6 - Before each match will be played the 1 cushion shot to determine the player starting first, with the white ball, and the right to start in case of a third set.

3.7 - Players have the right to ask for a pause of approximately 5 minutes after the second set.

In case of TV footage the organizer has the right to extend the pause or adding other pauses between the other sets.

4.0 - Classifications of the players after round robin matches

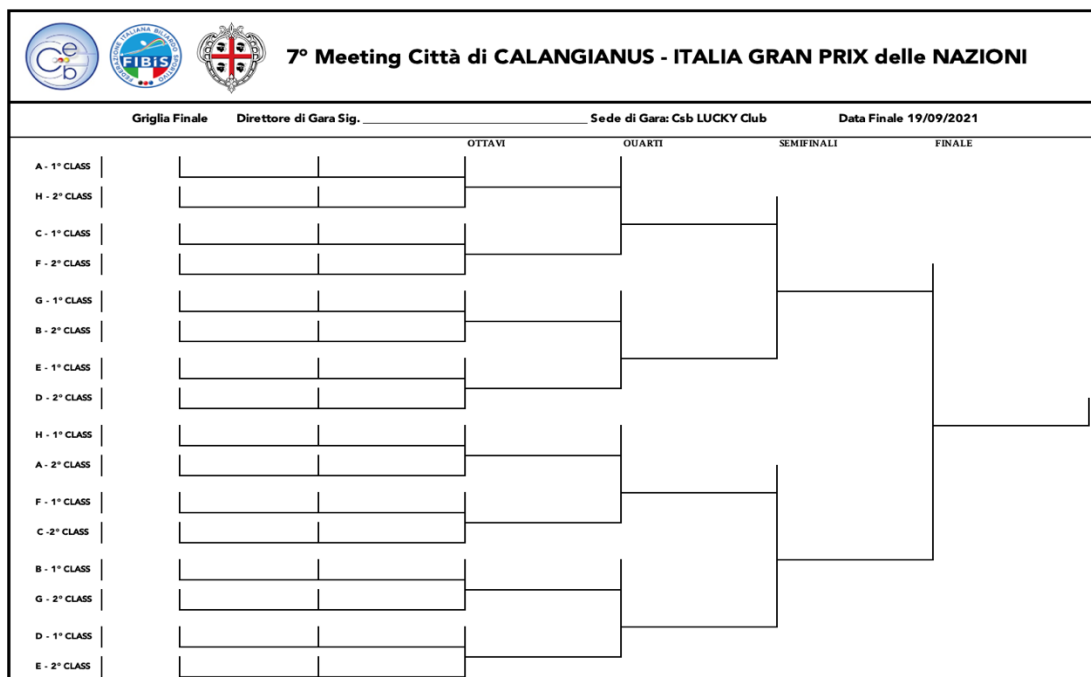
1) Matches won;

2) In case of same number of matches won the difference between sets won and sets loss will be considered;

3) In case of a new equality the average between points made and points suffered will be considered.

5.0 - Final draw

The first two players of each group, for a total of 16 players qualified, will move into the KO round, best of 3 sets to 120 points and will be positioned in the draw as follows:



6.0 - Prize Money

6.1 – All seeded players will benefit from a full indirect coverage of travel expenses, accommodations, meals.

The organizer will coordinate and liaise this agreement through his operating team and arrange the different players needs.

6.2 - The organizer will pay travel expenses, accommodation and meals both for CEB delegate than for CEB Sports Director.

7.0 - CEB Organization Fee

The CEB organization fee (€ 1000,00) is due as per CEB statute and rules. Fibus is legally responsible for this.

The amount has to be paid and settled from Fibus right after the invoice from the CEB and in any case 12 weeks before the tournament starts..

8.0 - Seeded players



No inscription fee is due from seeded players.

All the seeded players must be subscribed by their national federation and this has to be communicated by mail to: stecca@fibis.it

9.0 - Players sponsorships

CEB rules apply.

Players must wear their national team uniform.

Organizer has the right to ask the players to show a certain advertising and/or to forbid them to show personal advertising.

CEB will check the uniform of each player including advertising before the start of the match.

Any difference may occur into uniform and/or sponsorships has to be authorized in advance by CEB Sport Director.

Should this not happen, the player will be immediately suspended.

This rule has to be part of the invitation to seeded players.

10.0 - ANTI-DOPING

NADO (anti-doping agency) could do tests to the players during the tournament.

Costs, up to 4 tests, have to be settled by the tournament organizer.

11.0 - Other rules

Any other rule not hereby specified here will be taken from CEB rules and statutes..

12.0 - Entry into force

These rules are valid only for the 7th Meeting Città di Calangianus - Italia Gran Prix delle Nazioni.
